Burgundy, France (13% abv)

*Bursting with ripe tropical fruit characters, balanced by concentrated limey acidity and a lick of spicy oak.*

*Hauntingly fragrant, reminiscent of almond and peach blossom.*

**Gevrey Chambertin, Domaine Lucien Boillot 2005**

Burgundy, France (13% abv)

*Complex aromas of black cherries and raspberry jam precede a well balanced palate of plum flavours and modest tannins.*

**Barolo di Serralunga d'Alba, Fontanafredda 2003**

Piemonte, Italy (14% abv)

*A clear cut, intense nose with overtones of vanilla and spices.*

**Chateau Tayac, Cru Bourgeois, Margaux 1999**

Bordeaux, France (12.5% abv)

*Medium-bodied and dry with a firm palate comprising dark forest fruits.*

**Vina Cerrada, Rioja Gran Reserva 1999**

Rioja, Spain (13.5% abv)

*Ripe fruits of sultanas and compote on the nose, accompanied by cinnamon, vanilla and toast.*

**Chateauneuf du Pape Tradition, Domaine de la Janasse 2004**

Rhone, France (14.5% abv)

*Deep red-ruby. Fruit-driven aromas of cassis, redcurrant, smoke and spice. Soft, lush and ripe, with enticing fruit and good balance.*
